

Schirle Summary Report

Background

The purpose of this document is to focus on compensation patterns at the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences. The RFHS Schirle Working Group guides this work (Chair: Jackie Gruber).

The dataset used to inform this document was collected reflecting March 2020. There were 2,346 provided in April 2020, and an additional 732 records (representing AESES) were provided in September 2020. These records were collected by Human Resources (Contact: Dave Muir), and anonymized, before being sent to the Office of Educational and Faculty Development (Contact: Helen Mawdsley) for analysis. The data was received in an Excel format, and was imported into SPSS v27 for analysis. Overall, the 3,078 records span the following compensation groups at the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences:

Following key points and recommended discussion points below, a current status is provided for UMFA, Research Academic, Other Academic, EMAPS, and AESES.

Key Points (See Current Status sections of this document, and Preliminary Findings document for further details):

- Overall, females are represented more in the Instructor ranks and Assistant Professor ranks, and males are represented more in the Associate Professor and Professor ranks; however, this varies at the College level.
- More males than females increase their UMFA rank over the course of their career.
- Structured salary scales, as found in EMAPS and AESES have a relatively comparable distribution of salary across genders; however, Research Academics and Other Academics have a greater representation of males in higher salaries.

Recommended Discussion Points:

- Review the promotion and tenure environment to explore why some seek an increase and rank, and why some may pause on that.
- Review ability and autonomy for Research Academics and Other Academics to negotiate salary, including merit increases.

Current Status – UMFA

The 305 records are distributed across the position categories in the whole RFHS as follows:

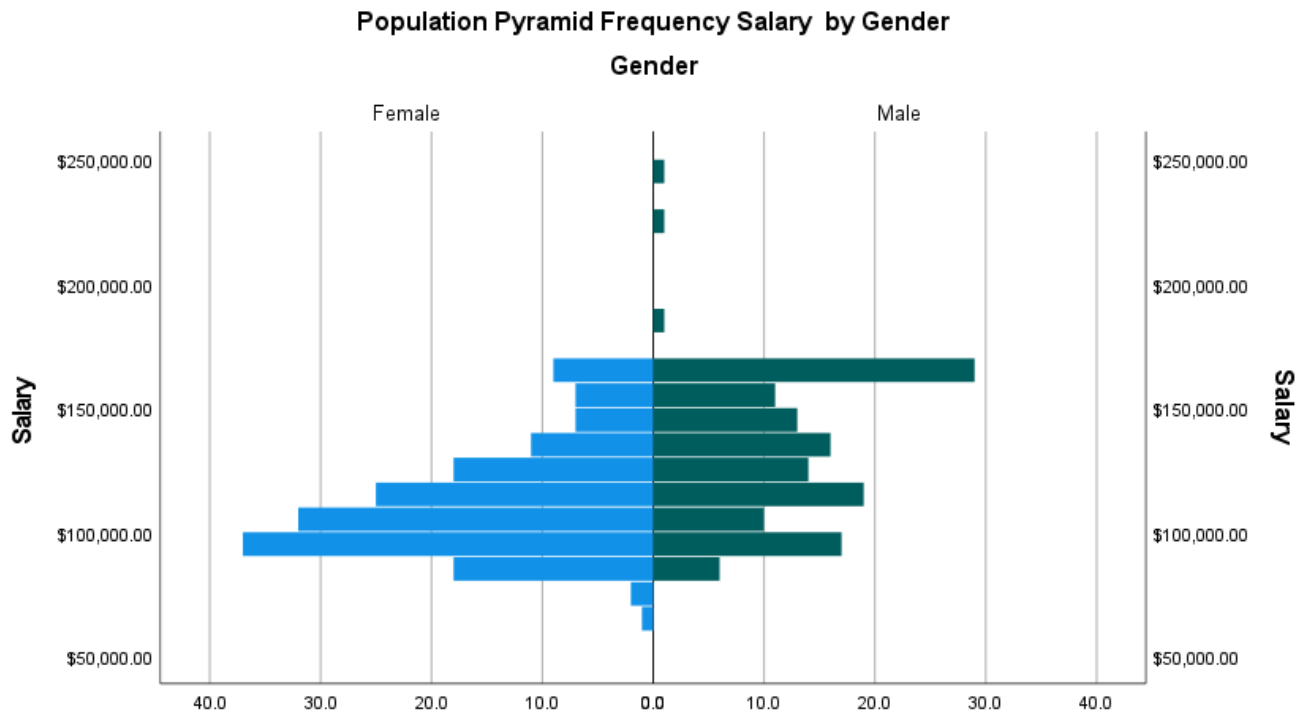

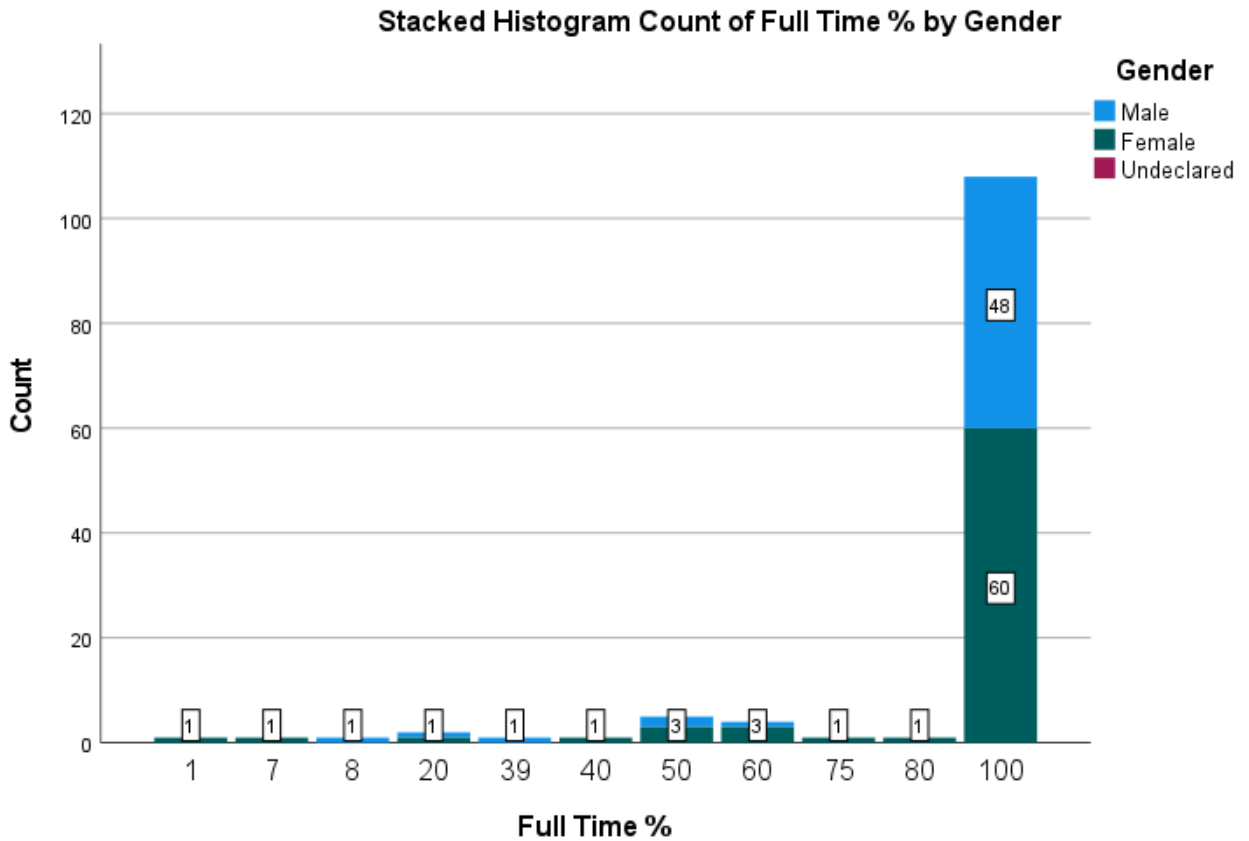

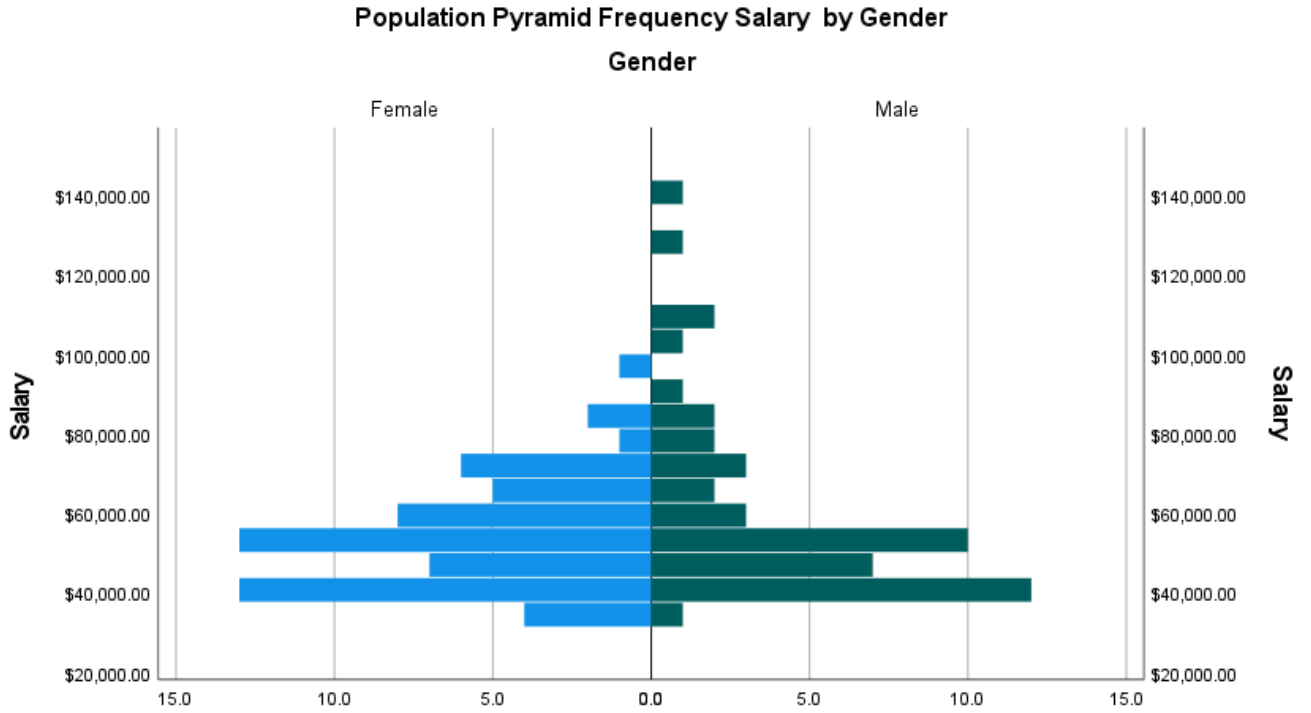

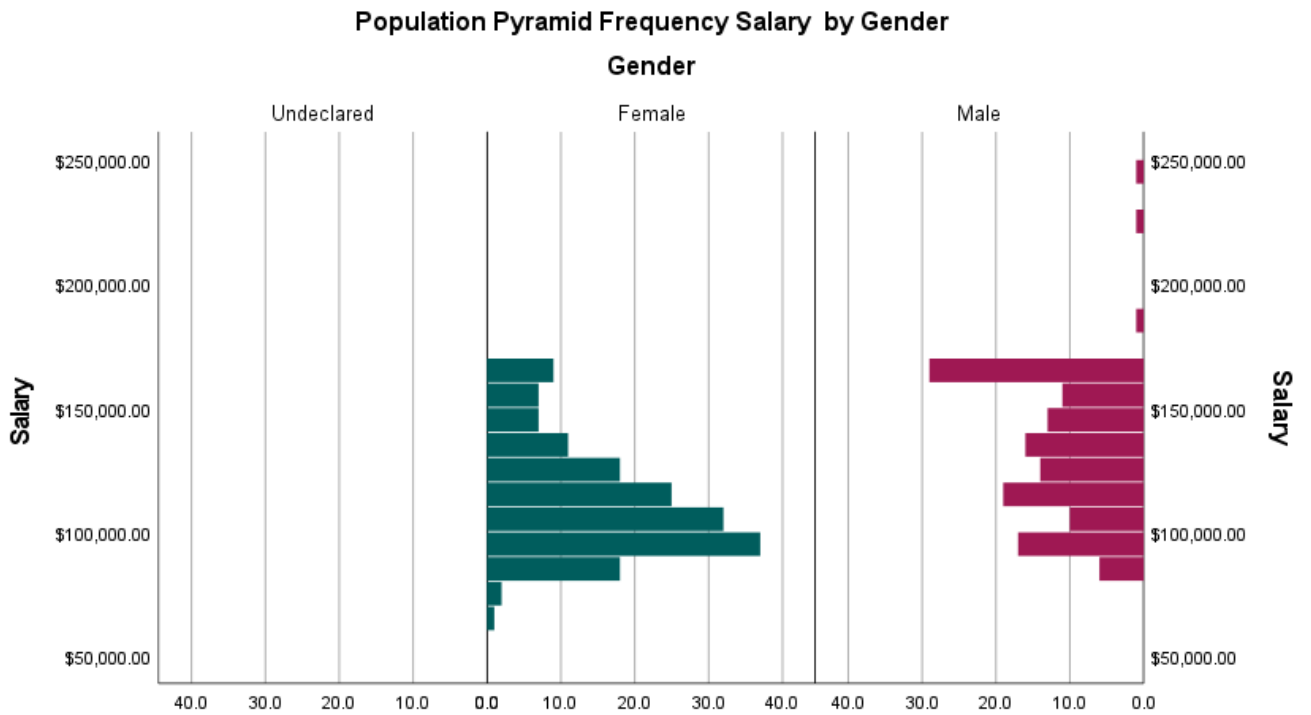

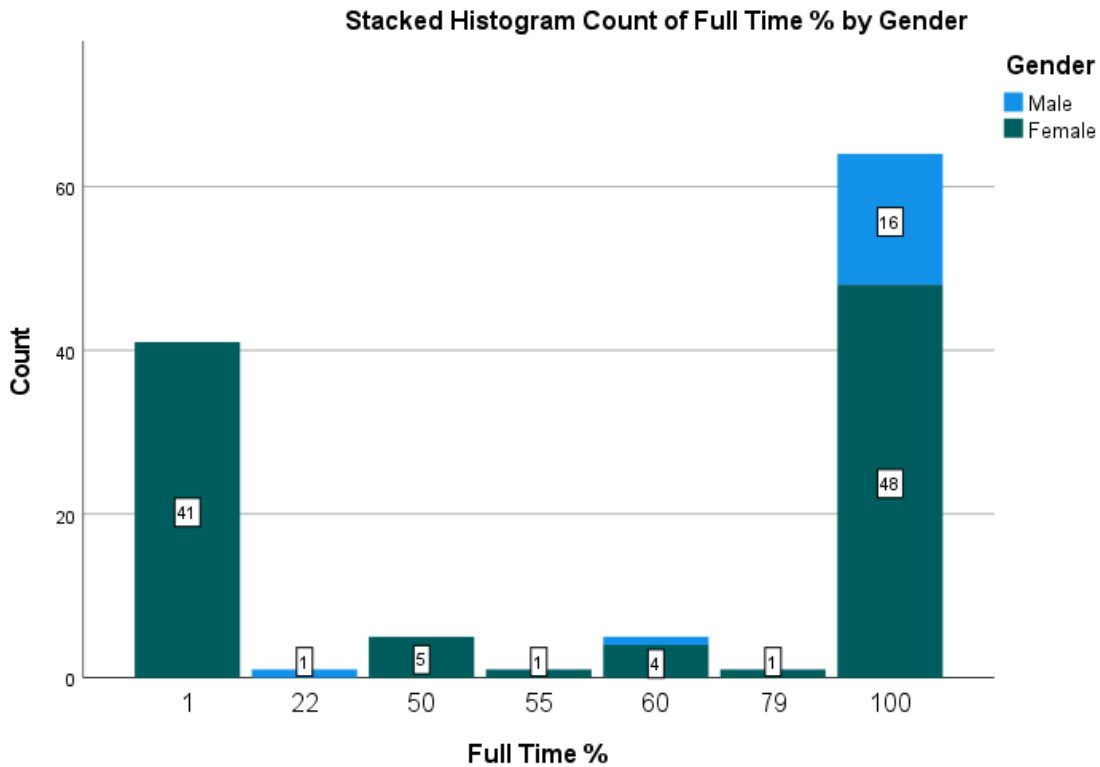

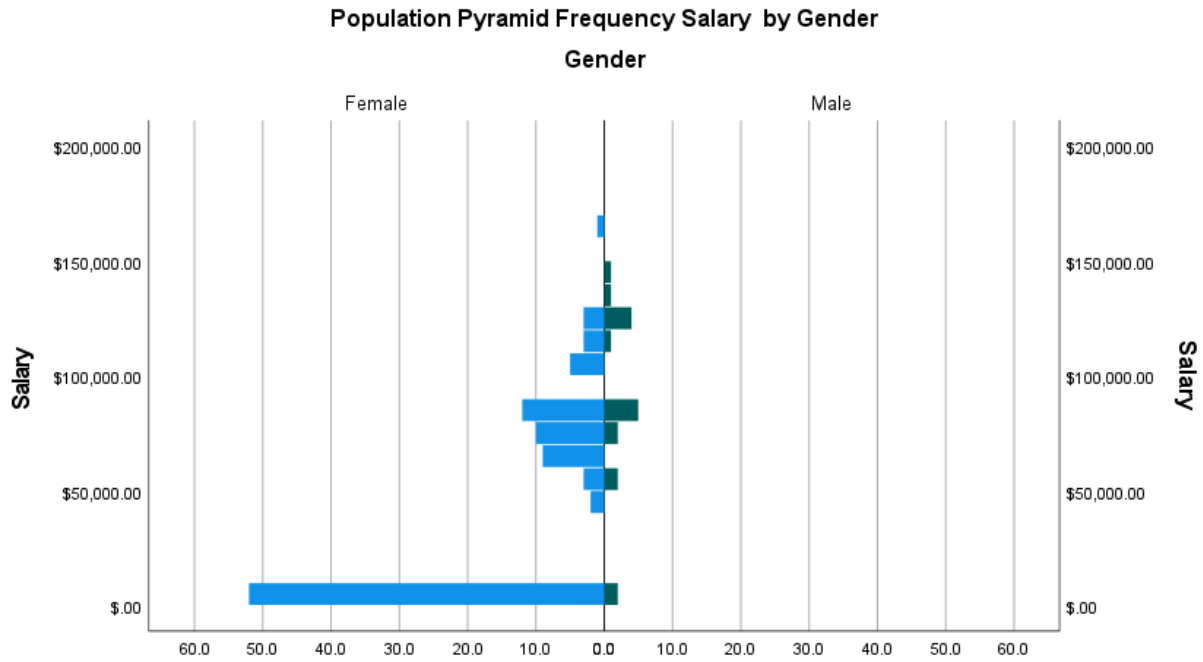

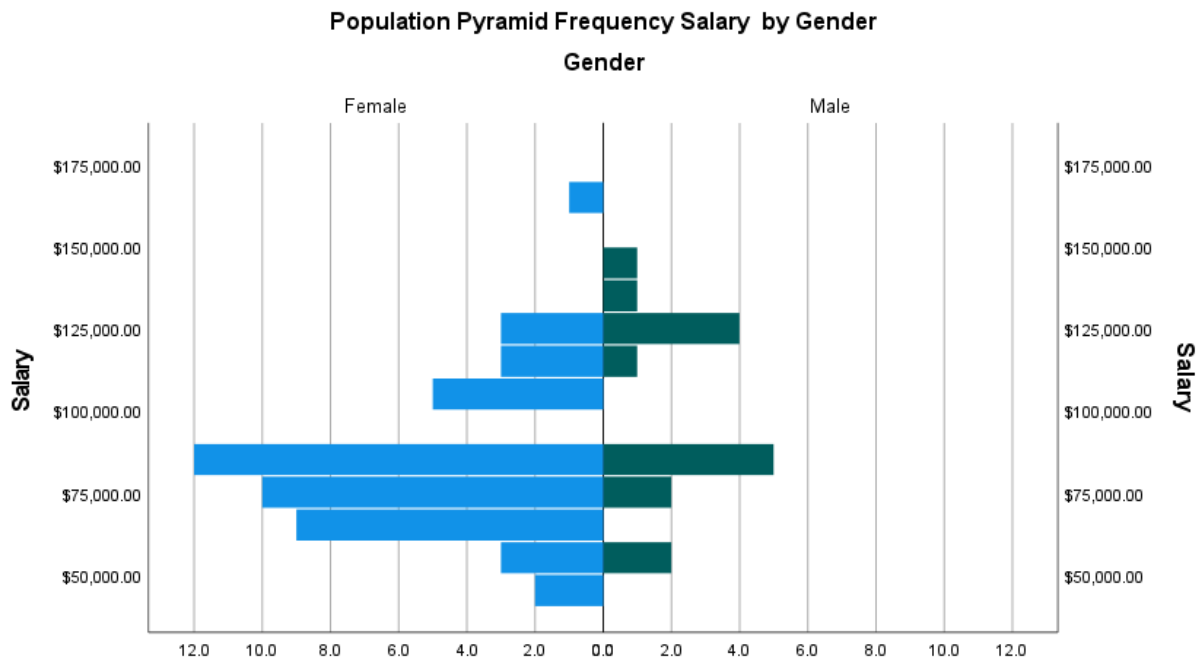

Salary distribution for all full-time EMAPS employees:

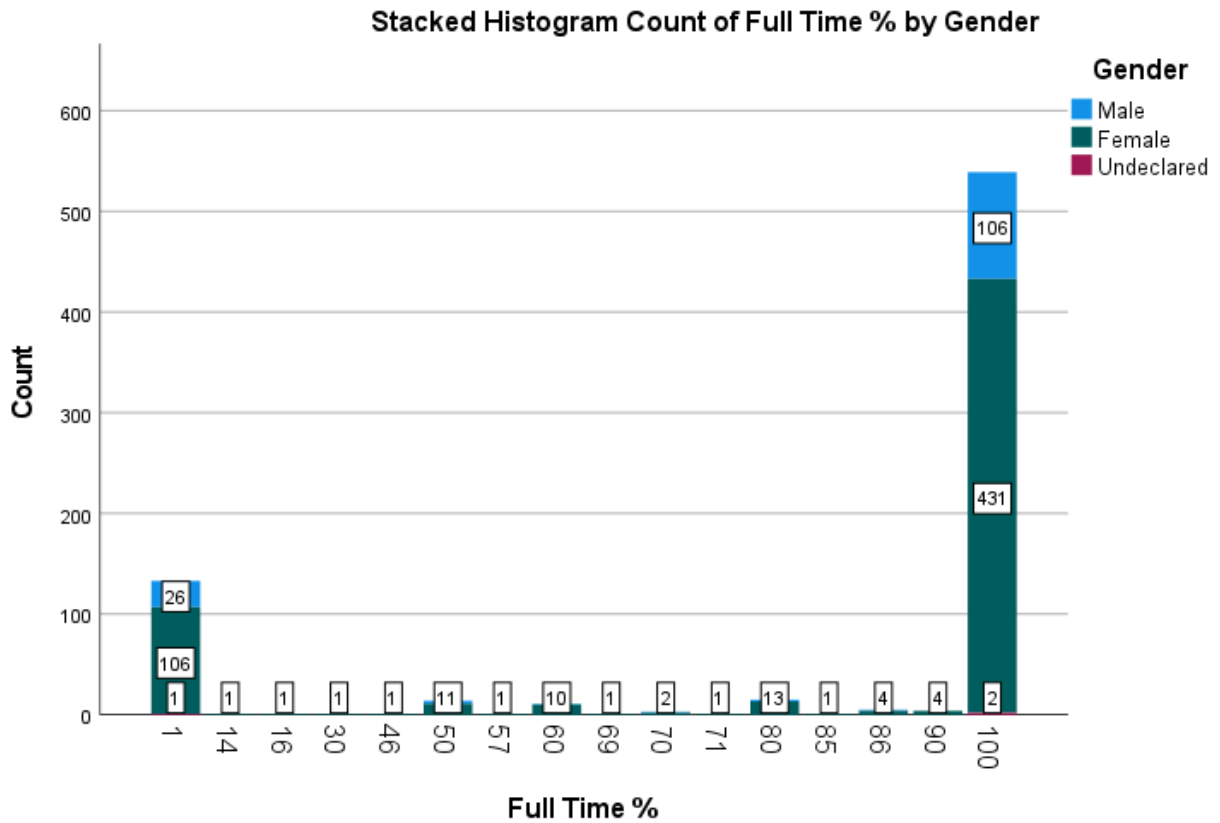

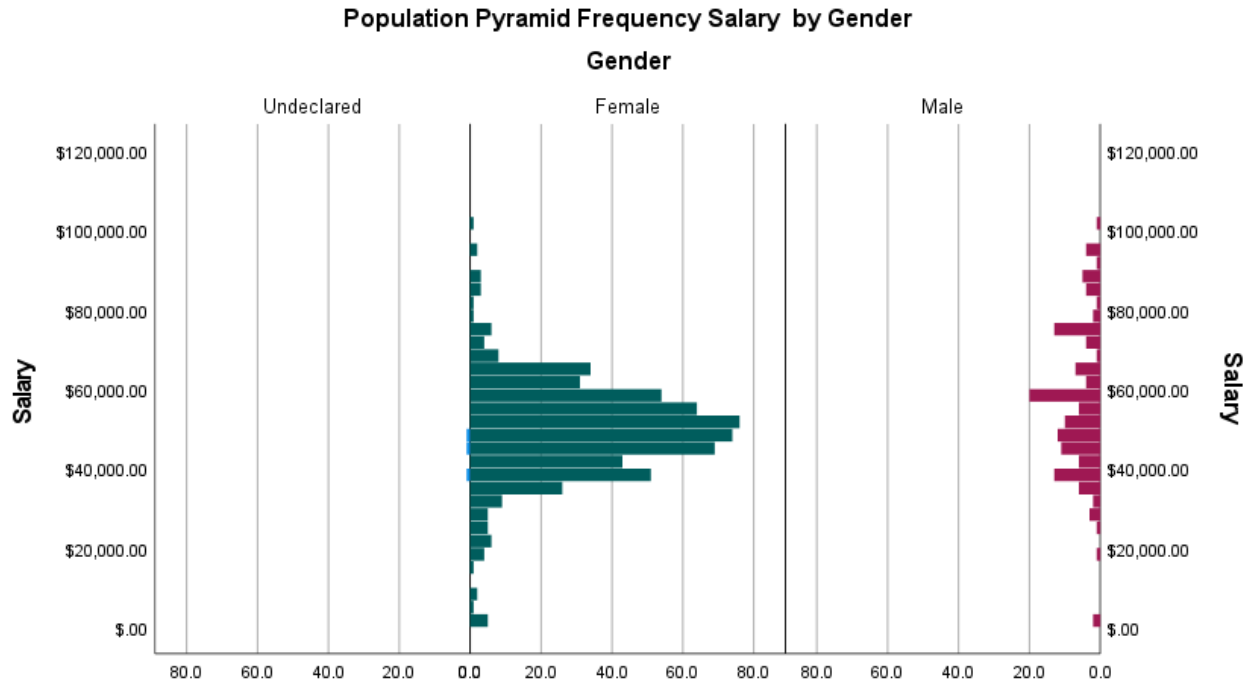
